

LEEDS FESTIVAL 2009 – GUEST CAMPERVAN & CARAVAN CONDITIONS

Access and use of the Guest campervan/caravan area is provided subject to the following Festival Republic Terms and Conditions. Application for a permit constitutes your acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Please read them carefully.

- These notes relate to customers with WEEKEND GUEST TICKETS ONLY. If you do not have a Guest Ticket, please see separate Terms and Conditions for the public campervan area.
- Separate fields for guest ticket holders to park campervans and caravans are available in the Guest area. This designated area of the site is the only place where guest ticket holders can sleep in vehicles – these vehicles will only be allowed in the fields if they have living accommodation with fitted sleeping facilities and either fitted cooking or washing facilities.
- No other vehicles will be allowed entry under any circumstances, not even late replacement vehicles in the case of a breakdown. Caravans must be towed on to the field by a car with a tow bar. Campervans are not allowed to be towed, even in the case of a breakdown. Unsuitable vehicles, including unconverted vans, with tickets for the campervan/caravan fields, will not be allowed entry and will be sent to one of the festival car parks – and, as it is contrary to our licence, security patrols will not permit sleeping in any vehicles in these car parks.
- Trailer tents and Caravans are permitted.
- Guest Campervan Permits are only valid with GUEST WEEKEND TICKETS. Each person with the vehicle must have a Guest Weekend ticket and ONLY guest weekend ticket holders will be permitted in the guest campervan area. Tickets and permits must be arranged in advance.
- All vehicles other than towing vehicles must be parked in the car parks. Towing vehicles must remain in the same field as caravans, not parked elsewhere.
- Campervans will be parked in rows.
- There may be space for ONE tent OR an awning to be erected per campervan subject to space/demand and campervan field staff approval.
- There is NO water or electricity hook available; however there will be a water point in the campsite for general use.
- No vehicles are to be parked in the fire lanes at any time.
- No trading of any kind is permitted from campervans.
- No sound systems are to be operated in the campervan fields. Anyone found operating such systems may be liable to eviction.
- GENERATORS, GLASS, Fireworks, audio recorders, gas canisters over 7kg in gas weight, illegal substances, portable laser equipment including laser pens or any illegal or offensive items ARE NOT PERMITTED in this field and will be confiscated.
- Excessive amounts of alcohol / cigarettes i.e. more than for personal consumption are not permitted. Any alcohol in the possession of anyone under 18 is not permitted.
- No animals other than guide dogs are permitted anywhere at the Festival.
- Persons suspected of carrying items which may be used in an offensive or dangerous matter, or carrying out illegal activities may be searched including their vehicle.
- All waste-water (grey water) must be emptied into containers provided. It is illegal to pour waste-water onto the ground, into a sump or into a stream. This will be monitored by the Environment Agency.

Guest Caravan/Campervan ticket holders must use the toilets provided and must not pollute streams or hedges. Toilets are provided in the camping area for your use, but there are no portable toilet emptying points.

- Open fires are not permitted. Barbecues can be used in these fields, but they must be at least 3m away from any vehicle.
- The fields must be clear by 5pm on the Monday. Any remaining vehicles will be removed.
- Please use litter bins and recycling bins before leaving the site
- Please respect the Country Code at all times.
- The Guest Campervan field will be patrolled by security staff. Facilities provided within the guest area include water, waste-water containers, toilets and a food trader. There is no electricity provided for field users.
- Entry to the guest campervan field is priced at £10.
- To apply for a guest campervan pass, please email guestcampervans@festivalrepublic.com stating Leeds. A member of the guest team will contact you regarding how to purchase a pass.
- The security staff will also check for any items not permitted on site, as specified in the terms and conditions on weekend tickets. Security staff will confiscate any such items and may refuse entry to the site. The decision of the security team will be final.
- Security staff may evict those that do not adhere to the conditions above, and may also confiscate their festival weekend tickets and any contraband items.
